
# MISSOURI FILM OFFICE

FOR FY25

The Missouri Film Office works to attract productions to the Show-Me State. This office serves as the central point of contact for all statewide inquiries related to film, TV, web and digital media.


## 2025 The Missouri Film Office assisted 202 projects in 2025, with 54 approved for the Motion Media Production Tax Credit Program.

These approved projects accounted for \$15.7 million in tax credits, generating an estimated \$40.7 million in qualified Missouri spending and employing 2,154 Missouri residents in cast and crew roles.




## 2024 The Missouri Film Office assisted 190 projects in 2024, with 39 approved for the Motion Media Production Tax Credit Program.

These approved projects accounted for \$12.4 million in tax credits, generating an estimated \$33.5 million in qualified Missouri spending and employing 1,437 Missouri residents in cast and crew roles.




The incentive program launched in October 2023. In the first year, \$2,775,956 of tax credits were approved to one feature film and one short film. Those two projects generated \$6,948,386 in qualified expenditures in Missouri and employed 550 Missouri residents.
